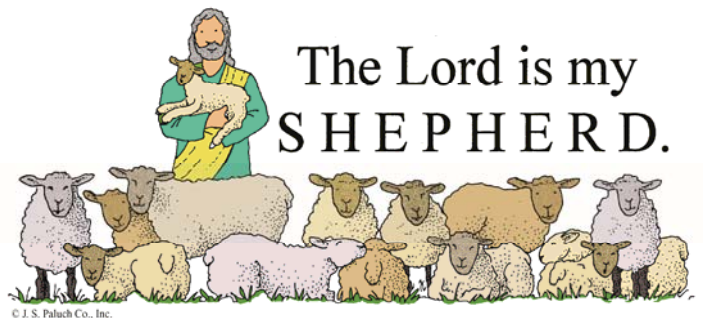

Questions of the Week:

Question for Children: How do you keep Sunday as a day of rest?

Question for Youth: Jesus was moved with pity for the people who were gathered. Who are the people you are moved with pity for? What can you do to help them?

Question for Adults: Why is rest important, and how do you make sure you get enough of it in your own life?

Activity of the week:

What do you do and where do you go when you feel overwhelmed? Take time to rest during the week. Find a quiet place and invite Jesus to join you during your rest.

Holy Moment:

Sometimes life gets so busy that we forget to put God first. It is in the busiest times that we need the guidance of the Holy Spirit the most. This week, find a quiet place and, if you are able, burn an incense stick while you pray. Do not allow any distractions during this time. You may play soft music if you choose but keep your focus on God. Journal about your experience and write a short prayer to say for the rest of the week.
